



Covid 19 Update to Mathematics Policy

The following additions to our policy have been made in light of guidance published by the Government regarding Covid 19 and the wider opening of school.

(<https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/actions-for-schools-during-the-coronavirus-outbreak/guidance-for-full-opening-schools> July 2nd 2020). All of the following expectations have been put in place to ensure the safety of our whole school community.

Social distancing:

- Stay in your own seat in the classroom or sit in the space you have been asked to.
- Pupils will sit side by side facing the front.

Resources:

- Each table will have a set of resources which will be shared between two pupils.
- Useful areas in classrooms are suspended at this time and children should not collect their own resources.
- Resources within the 'bubble' can be shared.
- Resources must be cleaned using the cleaning products provided if they are going to be shared with another bubble. Plastic resources **MUST** be left for 72 hours before another bubble can use. For other materials this is 48 hours.
- Resources stored in Staff room resource cupboard. **If resources are needed from the cupboard, they are to be taken to the classroom. Once used, cleaned (follow guidance above) and stored within the classroom or outside in Year group area for the time period mentioned above. Once time has lapsed, items can be returned.**

Active Maths/Maths of the Day:

- Pupils to wash hands before and after the activity.
- Remind pupils of social distancing.
- Use outdoor spaces as much as possible.
- Resources used to be cleaned as per guidance.

ICT:

- When using IT equipment, ensure that this is cleaned before and after use using the provided equipment.
- IT being shared between bubbles **MUST** be left for the required time before use.
