

Guidance for Liverpool schools on MFL delivery and COVID-19

The guidance below should be read in conjunction with the MFL Risk Assessment for Classroom Delivery and COVID-19 document.

- ✓ Lessons can be taught in normal classrooms unless the style of lesson demands more space eg one that requires physical movement and/or prolonged singing. In which case the hall or outdoor space would be recommended.
- ✓ Group size should be in line with social distancing measures. There must be adequate space for the tutor to remain 2m from pupils whilst also allowing him/her room to move around in order to demonstrate activities.
- ✓ Adequate time is allowed within the MFL session for both MFL tutors and support teachers to sanitise resources and reduce extended periods of exposure to possible infection.

In order to deliver provision in a safe way your school will...

- 1. Provide a full and detailed risk assessment which includes measures specific in relation to visiting tutors.
- 2. Provide a member of staff to be present within all lessons. The role for this individual is to manage any personal care and support with resource management and the cleaning of resources where needed.
- 3. Provide paper towels and appropriate access to sanitising resources.
- 4. Provide a safe and well ventilated space for activity (we would recommend the hall)
- 5. Provide access to a screen and laptop which is regularly sanitised.

In order to deliver provision in a safe way MFL SIL will...

- 1. Provide a full and detailed risk assessment with specific measures in place to deliver MFL where social distancing is at the core of all provision.
- 2. Abide by all school control measures for safe working practices in relation to COVID-19.
