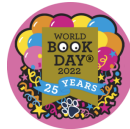

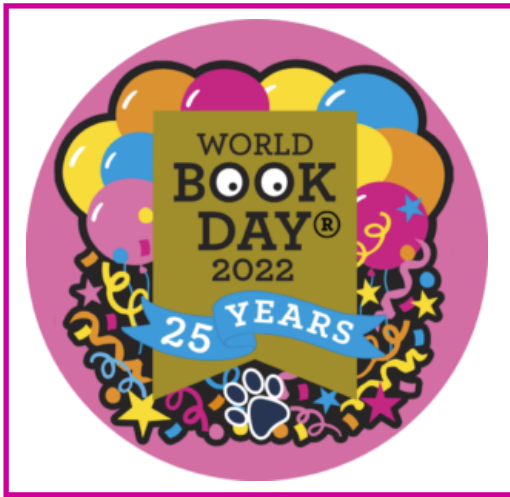

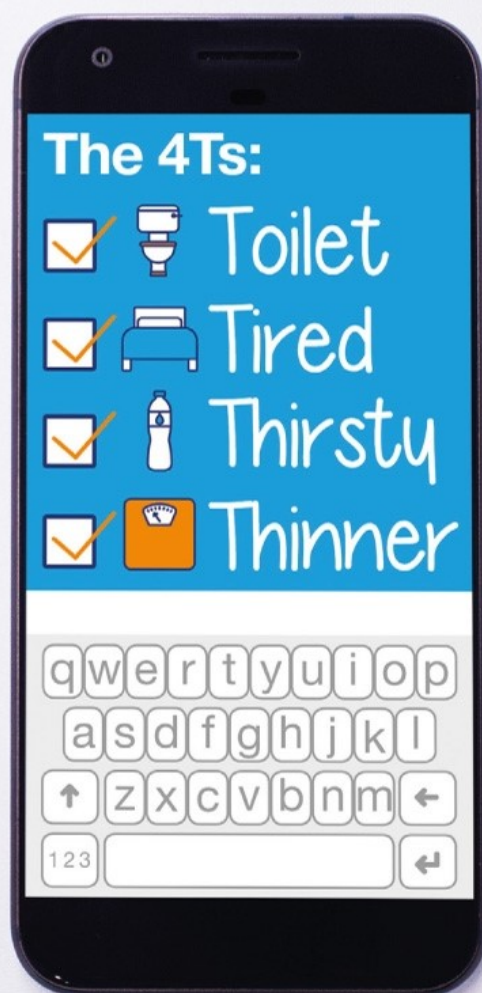
The children had a wonderful time celebrating World Book Day in school.
