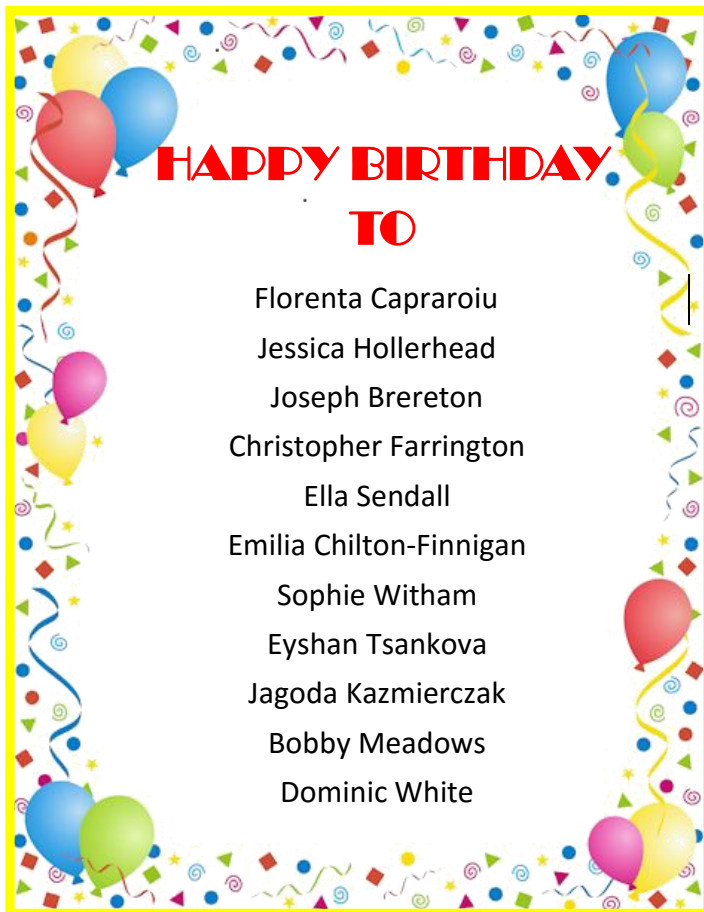

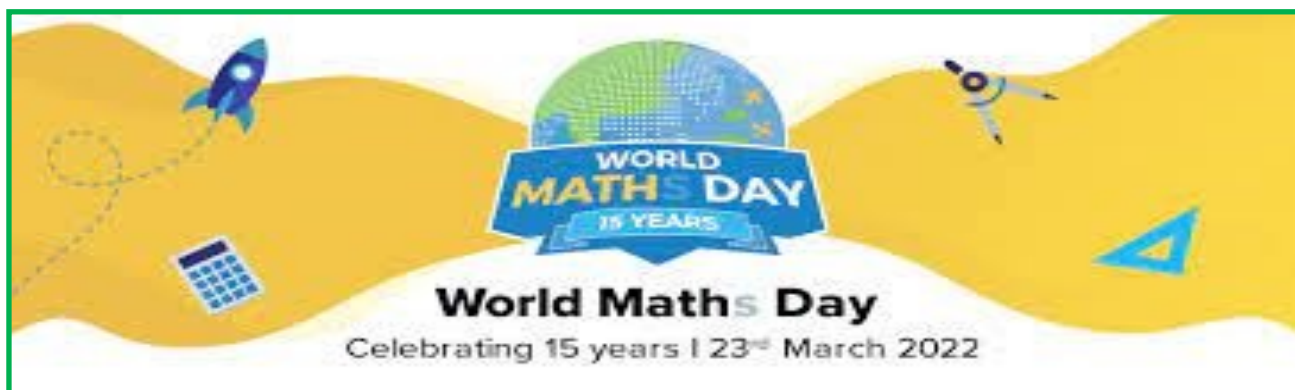

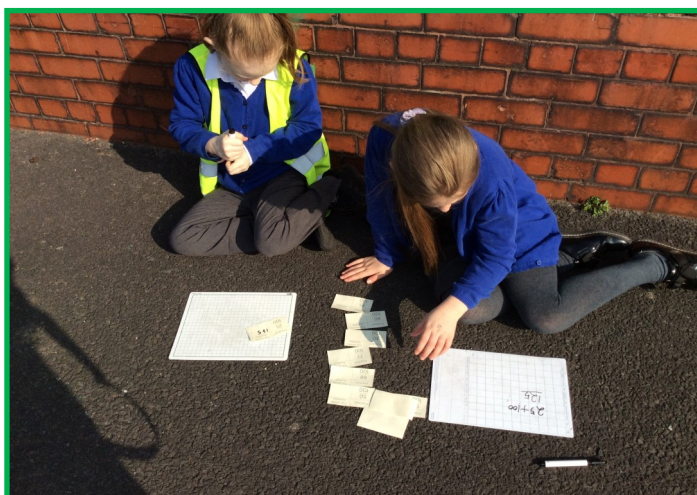

This week Reception have enjoyed using non-standard units of measurement to explore length and height. We measured each other and compared who was the tallest and who was the shortest.

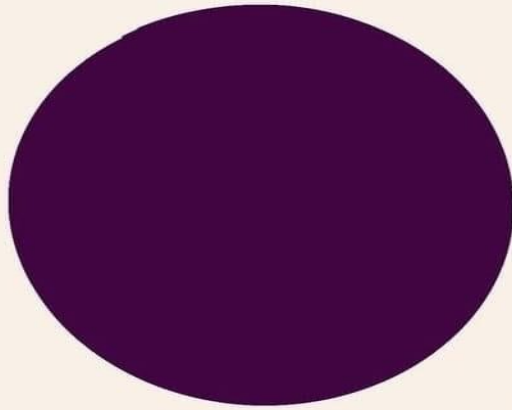

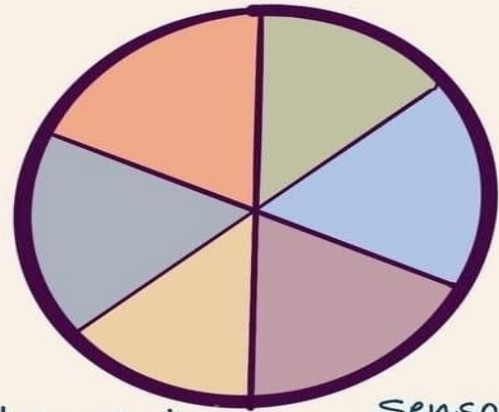
