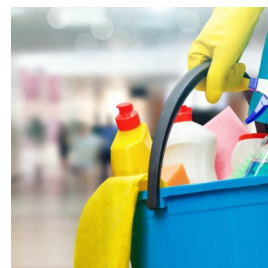

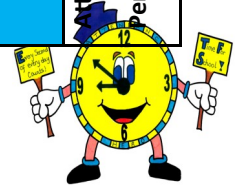

Year 2 started the morning with a surprise...

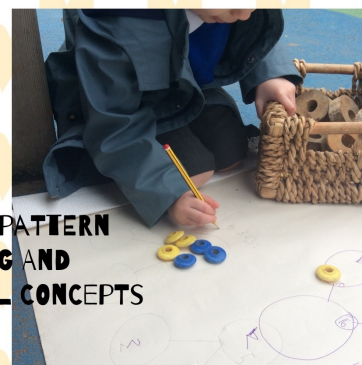

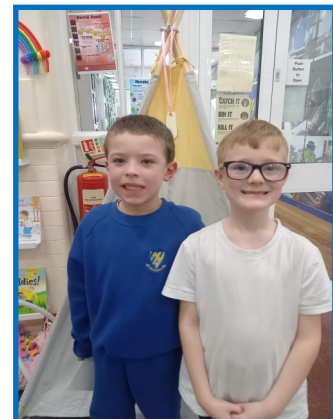

Liverpool Citizens Support Scheme
