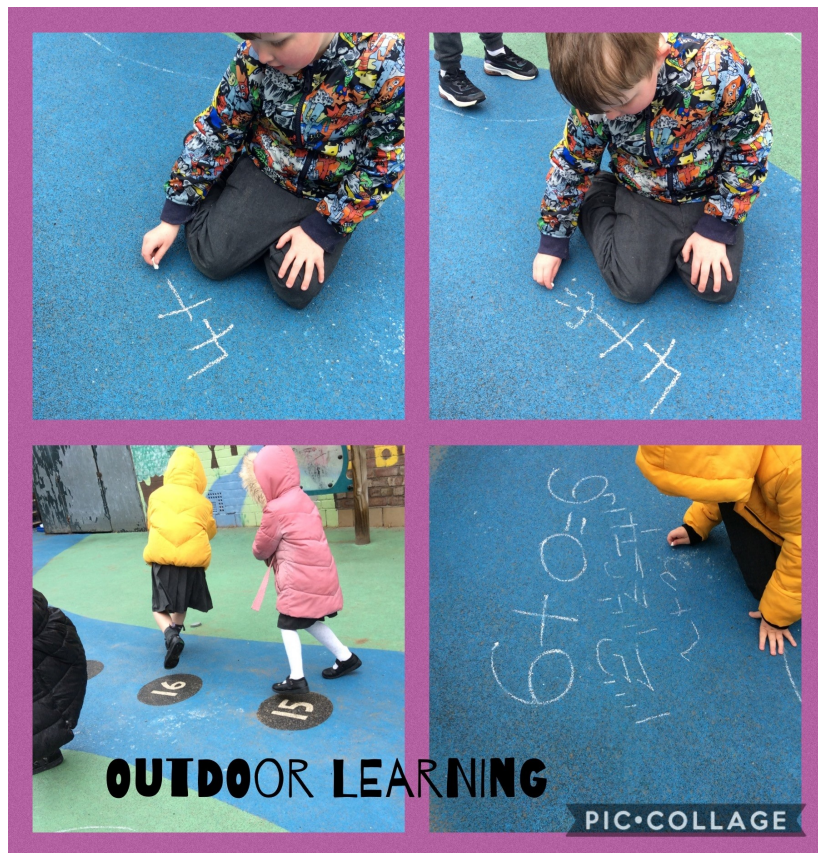

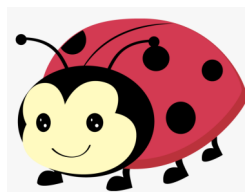




## Look at the wonderful week Reception have had.



This week in Reception we have enjoyed exploring the vocabulary concept 'around'. We have been learning the Nursery rhyme simple Simon and have enjoyed exploring our Narrative Immersion text the Jolly Postman, making invitations to invite our friends to special events! We also found a number of snails in our garden and extended our vocabulary learning exploring words such as 'antenna' and 'habitat'. In Maths we have been working hard on our subitising skills, we have been reinforcing the importance of more and fewer and have been playing games outdoors to consolidate our understanding of number bonds to 10 recording using chalk and mathematical symbols. We have also been learning about 'deaf awareness'. We thought carefully about what it might feel like to be unable to hear. We have been learning new signs and songs to support sign language within class. What a busy week!
