# HOLIDAYS IN TERM TIME

Why you should not take your child on holiday in term time.

#### Your child may:

- Get behind in their school work.
- Feel excluded from their group of friends on their return.
- Not understand new work and lose self confidence.
- Get lower results in tests, assessments because of missed work.
- Miss tests or assessments.

Any absence in term time destroys the continuity of your child's education and may reduce chances of success.

## Is my child entitled to time off school for family holidays?

No. Parents/carers do not have the right for their child to have leave of absence for a holiday.

#### Are parents responsible for their child' attendance at school?

Yes, by law, parents whose children are registered at a school, are responsible for ensuring that their child attends school regularly. If they fail to do this they may be guilty of an offense and can be issued or prosecuted under section 444 of the Education Act 1996 with a penalty notice.

#### What are the penalties?

A Fixed Penalty Notice is a fine of £120 issued to each parent of each child absent on holiday.

# **Attendance Matters**

Whole School Target: 97% - This week's Whole school attendance: 91.17%

Absence—if your child is absent from school you MUST contact the school before 9:00am each day of your child's absence. Failure to make any contact with the school will result in a home visit from staff and Head teacher.

Appointments—should be arranged outside of the school day and if this is not possible, medical evidence should be provided.



All children in year 2 currently receive free school meals from the Government. When your child moves into the next school year, Year 3, you will be charged £2 per day for them to have a school meal. If you are in receipt of certain benefits or on a low income you may be entitled to Free school meals from the Local Authourity.

Use the link attached to check if you are eligible for free school meals. Please apply NOW so it is in place before your child starts Year 3. This benefit can not be back dated so any charges made, you will be responsible for paying.
