

This week in Year 3 we have had a very enjoyable time exploring 'textiles' in our art lessons. We have explored different textiles from around the world and we had the opportunity to dip dye our very own piece of fabric in preparation for our printing next week. In maths we have been busy looking at 'Statistics' and we have enjoyed looking at both pictograms and bar charts and learning how to interpret the information which they present.
