MESSAGE FROM THE HEAD TEACHER

Dear parents/carers,

I can't believe where this half term has gone - it has flown by! We have had a lovely week in school. Wednesday was incredibly busy as pupils in Nursery and Reception had a visit from Acorn Farm and Y2 and Y4 had workshops delivered by Chester Zoo. The children (and staff) loved seeing the animals from the farm and our visitors included goats, sheep, chickens, a duck, a rabbit and a rat! Y2 and Y4 have also visited the zoo today and had an amazing, but tiring time! We have a committed small group of parents/carers who attend our Wednesday morning

Toddler Group and next term we will be moving the group back over to the main school so that the children can access the sensory room again. We would love to see some new participants and all are welcome!

After the holidays, Y1 will have their end of year statutory Phonics Screening Check pupils need to be in school every day. There is a limited period of time in which pupils can take the check. Y2's who did not achieve the check will also be involved in a 're-sit'.

Y4 will have their statutory multiplication check during the first two weeks back after the holiday so if you want to keep your child busy in the holidays, get practicing those times tables and make full use of our 'Timetable Rockstars' app.

Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) are stressful or traumatic experiences that can significantly impact us throughout our lives, both as children and young people **and** as adults.

When a care giver abuses things, alcohol or gambling.

Physical, verbal, financial, coercive control.

There are things we can all do to address adversity you or others may be facing

Get to know yourself. Understand and appreciate who you are as a person.

Show empathy and have compassion. Be kind to yourself and others.

Create safety and choice, for yourself and those around you.

Look at the big picture - think about things from different angles. Explore what could make a difference in the situation, however small.

Actively find and build on positives - seek out and do things that make you and your family stronger.

Join the FREE ACE-Aware sessions and learn:

- What are ACEs.
- The impact ACEs can have.
- The ACEs framework: five ways we can adapt our practice and interactions with others to buffer the impact of ACEs.
