- Grey skirt/pinafore or trousers.
- White polo shirt.
- Grey socks or tights.



#### Years 3/4/5/6

pupil's uniform will be:

- Royal blue V neck jumper or cardigan.
- Grey skirt/pinafore or trousers.
- White shirt.
- School tie.
- Grey socks or tights.







#### All children from Reception through to year 6 also require a PE kit.

This consists of:

A white round neck t-shirt.

Royal blue shorts.

Royal blue jogging bottoms and Sweatshirt can also be worn. Black pumps or black trainers only.

#### YEAR 4





Well done children , we are very proud of you., were excellent representatives for Gwladys Street.












