




In DT this week we have been exploring structures. The children have thought carefully about what makes a structure stable and they have then designed and created their own chair for baby bear!


YEAR 3

YEAR 4




In Maths, we have been looking at 4 digit numbers. The children have worked hard to partition and estimate different numbers up to 10,000.




Spanish Culture Day






