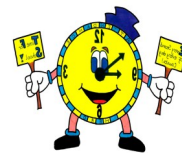




YEAR 4




In Science this week we looked at freezing and how something changes from a liquid to a solid. We made ice cream. We had to shake the bag really hard to mix the mixture.

YEAR 5




This week, in Year 5, we used role play to gather ideas that we added to a role on the wall. We described what our character would be able to see on the lunar surface and how this would make them feel.

YEAR 6




In science, we started our new topic 'The Science of Light' and conducted an investigation into rays of light.




The whole school celebrated Spanish Day on Friday.
