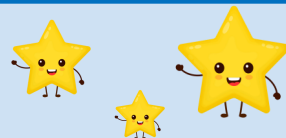

RECEPTION



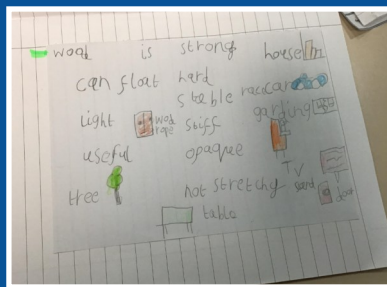

YEAR 4



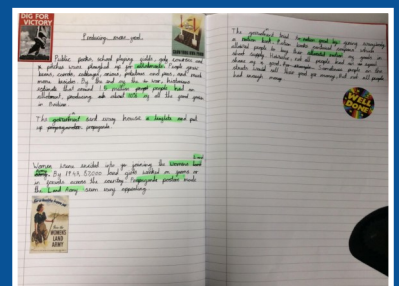
In Year 4 this week, we started our new unit on computing. We looked at making our own databases using different pictures. Great work everyone!

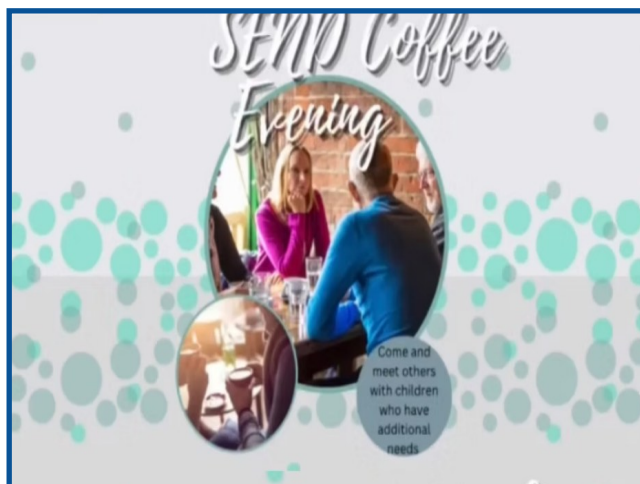
