### **Presentation in EYFS**

In our EYFS Literacy books, we will:

- introduce literacy exercise books within Reception year, as children begin to progress into more structured written communication
- display on the 1st page, a tracking sheet with the child's name, their writing assessments tracker and a pencil grip tracker
- place vulnerability stickers in the top right corner of each child's front cover
- ensure the 1st page of each book has the child's writing tracker glued in
- ensure that each half-term's learning begins with a picture (glued in) of the focus story and the writing outcomes displayed, and with a photo of the author
- Ensure written recording is evident at least ONCE per week from Spring Term
- Ensure written recording is evident at least THREE TIMES per week from Spring Term

#### In our EYFS Floor books we will:

- Display subject monitoring stickers on each double-page spread in the top right corner – with a short date
- Display the key worker book cover in the top left corner glued in
- Have key vocabulary created on Widgit and stuck in a max of 6 words
- Use colour pens to add notes, captions and details to the floor book
- Add a mixture photographs, children's work and children engaging in practical activities

### **Presentation & Expectations in Maths**

- Date is written in numbers Day Month Year then underlined using a ruler
- KS2 Write the date underneath in Roman Numerals
- 1 digit in each box
- All numbers formed correctly
- Diagrams drawn using a ruler
- Lines drawn using a ruler
- Shading must be crosshatched (teacher must demonstrate this)
- Vocabulary strip glued in straight along lines (underneath the number date)
- Front cover of books written in black handwriting pen
- Vulnerable groups sticker in the top right corner of front cover
- Daily Power Up glued into journals with calculating completed on the Power Up (if required) or presented underneath the Power Up.




- Correct letter formation

- Key vocabulary strip trimmed correctly with an equal border around
- Key vocabulary strip to have \_\_\_\_ font style and \_\_\_\_ font size
- No empty boxes within the key vocabulary strip
- Any sheets, diagrams, images, including the Pre-assessment question to be glued against the margin
- Sheets, diagrams, images, questions to be trimmed straight
- Larger sheets to be folded neatly and glued straight
- Front cover to have vulnerable groups sticker in the top right corner
- Front cover to have child's name and class written in black handwriting pen
- Any WALT or date stickers to be printed and stuck neatly and straight
- Diagrams drawn using a ruler
- Lines drawn using a ruler
- Sentence accuracy (SA) written in the margin
- Editing or responding to feedback completed in purple pen
- Numbers to mark questions to be written in the margin
- Bullet points/ numbered points in the margin
- Answers written against the margin


