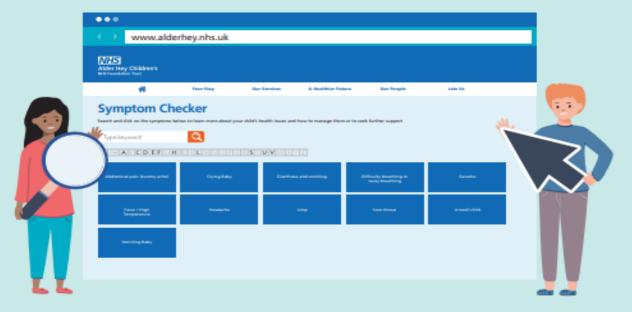


YEAR 3

YEAR 6




In spelling this week, we have been looking at rules for adding suffixes.


