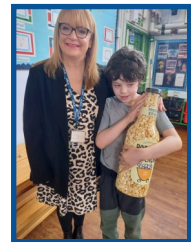

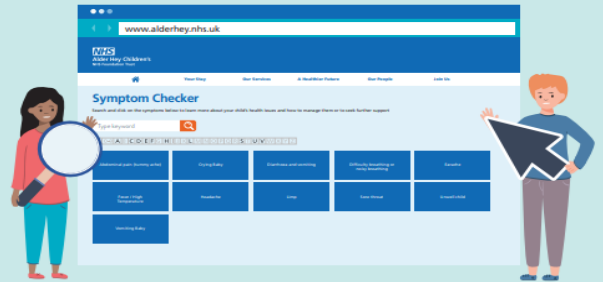

We had an amazing visit to the Liverpool World Museum this week, really enjoyed exploring the exhibits and having a chance to bring the learning we have done in the classroom to life!

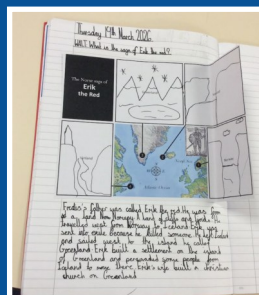


YEAR 4



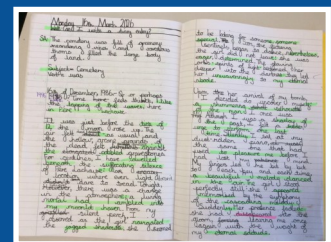
Year 4 have had lots of fun investigating how sound travels.


We've had another wonderful musical week at Gwladys Street.
