



RWI Spelling non- negotiables.

The following expectations must be followed when using the RWI spelling scheme. These non-negotiables will be looked at during learning walks and book looks.

- 15 minutes 3 times a week.
- Practice books must be dated each time they are completed- 3 dates per week.
- Logbooks are used each time a speed spell activity is completed and is used to write corrected spellings only.
- Every child needs a logbook, a practice book and a jotter.
- Every classroom should have their complex spelling chart displayed.
- Session 1 is speed spell and spelling zone (including video).
- Session 2 is dots and dashes and word changers.
- Session 3 is Team Teach- words to be logged in the logbook correctly including handwriting.
- Session 4 is Dictation- Year 2/3 dictation is teacher led and year 4/5/6 partner dictation.
- Session 5 is four in a row.
- Session 6 is a spelling test with ten words from the unit that has been covered.
- Spelling test scores must be logged in your teacher planner weekly and these will be monitored.
- Spelling test scores must also be logged onto the RWI spelling test tracker.
- 1 unit to be completed every two weeks.
- Live marking, peer and self-marking.
- Logbooks must be cared for because in some year groups they continue into the next year group. (Year 3 continues into year 4 and year 5 continues into year 6).
